Homonyms and homophones are often the cause of confusion; they are frequently used one for the other, but these two are different linguistic concepts.

On the other hand, a Homophone is a word that sounds the same as another, but is different in A Homonym is a word that has the same sound and spelling as another, but is different in meaning and origin. For example, the noun 'bear' and the verb 'bear' are homonyms of each other. spelling, meaning and origin. For instance, knew and new are homophones of each other. In real language situations, the boundary between homophones and homonyms often gets blurred. Thus, many words have some characteristics of both concepts. For this reason, homophones are quite often classified as homonyms.
